## **DESCRIPTION**

Handsome hand painted painted tray, shaped border, with a gilded rim, wide royal blue border, the centre painted with a a view of Laugharne Castle, Titled and signed Clark

Laugharne Castle (Welsh: Castell Talacharn) is in Laugharne, Carmarthenshire, Wales. The castle, located on the estuary of the River Tâf, was originally established in 1116. It was rebuilt as a Norman stronghold. There have been many alterations since then, including becoming a Tudor fortified manor house in the sixteenth century. It changed hands twice during the English Civil War, being eventually captured by

Parliamentary forces in 1644.
